

Code of Conduct for all members and visitors at Hunstanton Croquet Club

Show respect – Treat all people at the club with dignity and respect, regardless of their age, race, gender, ethnicity, religion or sexual orientation.

Maintain a safe environment – Be mindful of the safety of yourself and others on and off the croquet court. Follow safety guidelines and instructions from the officials.

Play fairly – Play the game in accordance with the rules and spirit of croquet and conduct yourself in a sportsmanlike manner.

Be respectful of the court and equipment – Take care of the playing surface, equipment and infrastructure. Report any damage to the club officials.

Assist in maintaining the club – Participate in work parties, assist in maintaining the facilities, and contribute to the improvement of the club.

Avoid disruptive behaviour – Behave in a manner that does not interfere with other members' enjoyment of the game or club events. Be mindful of visitors and those in neighbouring properties.

Be punctual – Arrive on time for club afternoons, scheduled matches, and work parties.

It is the collective responsibility of all to challenge breaches or let a committee member know of concerns.

By adhering to these guidelines, members of HCC will create a safe, welcoming, inclusive, and enjoyable environment for all.
