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HCC Tournament Regulations – GC 'August' Open Invitation

Singles

The Tournament will normally be open to a maximum of 20 players. It may possibly be extended (dependent on demand) to 24 players using all five lawns plus one Tennis Court (Double Banked).

The winners of the previous year's Tournament and the Manager will be automatically allocated a place should they choose to compete.

HCC will reserve six places for its own Club Members. Should the number wishing to participate be greater than six and the tournament is fully subscribed, then the six HCC members competing will be drawn by ballot on the allocation date from the entries received.

Should the Tournament be oversubscribed, the selection of the remaining entrants will be made by using the CA grading system to allocate places.

An allocation date of 01/05/23 will be used to notify all entrants.

Players will be split into two tournaments; (Level & Handicap). The Manager's decision on their allocation will be final.

The final allocation for Level/Handicap places will be made by using the CA grading system current as at 24/07/23.

Games will be played as 13 point timed at 1 Hour plus 8 shots (where necessary). Should the match scores then still be level the hoop shall be completed.

Both Tournaments will be decided by a semi-final followed by a final.

Doubles

The Tournament will be open to a maximum of 40 players using all five lawns (Double Banked).

The winners of the previous year's Tournament and the Manager will be automatically allocated a place should they choose to compete.

HCC will reserve eight places for its own Club Members. Should the number wishing to participate be greater than eight and the tournament is fully subscribed, then the eight HCC members competing will be drawn by ballot on the allocation date from the entries received.

Selection will be made using the CA grading system on the allocation date.

An allocation date of 01/05/23 will be used to notify all entrants.

Players will be allocated a playing partner by using the CA grading system current as at 24/07/23. The Manager's decision on this allocation will be final.

Games will be played as 13 point timed at 1 Hour plus 8 shots (where necessary). Should the match scores still be level the hoop shall be completed.

The Tournament will be decided by a semi-final followed by a final.
