HCC Tournament Regulations – GC August Open Invitation – Singles

1. The Tournament will be open to a maximum of 20 players and possibly extended to 24 players using all five lawns plus one Tennis Court (Double Banked).
2. The winners of the previous year’s tournament will be automatically allocated a place along with the Manager.
3. HCC will reserve six places for HCC members. Should the number wishing to participate be greater than six and the tournament be fully subscribed, then a ballot of HCC members will take place on the allocation date to determine the HCC members selected to participate.
4. Should the Tournament be oversubscribed, the selection of visitors will be made by using Croquet England’s grading system to allocate the places.
5. An allocation date of 1st May 2026 will be used to notify all entrants.

HCC Tournament Regulations – GC August Open Invitation – Doubles

1. The Tournament will be open to a maximum of 40 players using all five lawns (Double Banked).
2. The winners of the previous year’s tournament will be automatically allocated a place along with the Manager.

HCC will reserve eight places for HCC Members. Should the number wishing to participate be greater than eight and the tournament be fully subscribed, then a ballot of HCC members will take place on the allocation date to determine the HCC members selected to participate.

3. Should the Tournament be oversubscribed, the selection of visitors will be made by using Croquet England’s grading system to allocate the places.
4. An allocation date of 1st May 2026 will be used to notify all entrants.
